Lacombe, Alberta (July 3, 2019) – ECHO Lacombe Association is happy to announce funding support for the construction of the World's Largest Fishing Lure now located at Len Thompson Fish Pond.

"Our board views a project that can deliver significant media attention and exposure to our community as a real positive," said ECHO Lacombe Association President Drayton Bussiere. "I understand there has been a steady stream of visitors to the pond already and we are excited to see that trend continue."

Brad Pallister, Len Thompson Fishing Lures echoed those sentiments.

"We wanted to find a unique way to celebrate our 60th year in Lacombe (90th overall)," said Pallister. "One of our employees suggested the lure concept and we were immediately sold. But the response from the community and across the Province has well exceeded our expectations. Working with Echo Energy, Lacombe Fish & Game and Comet Welding to make this project a reality has been a really rewarding experience."

The ECHO Lacombe Association president is proud of the momentum Echo Energy is beginning to generate.

About the World's Largest Fishing Lure

The Lure is a massive 40 feet, 5 inches long version of the famous Len Thompson No. 2 Five of Diamonds. The spoon weighs in at nearly 2600 lbs and the hook 900 lbs. Currently, the world record holder is located in Texas and measures at a length of 15 feet, 6 inches long. Dimensions have been submitted to Guinness for verification and confirmation of the world record.
